

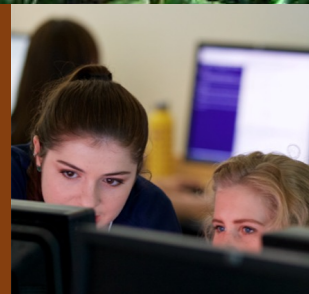

June 10 – June 14, 2024

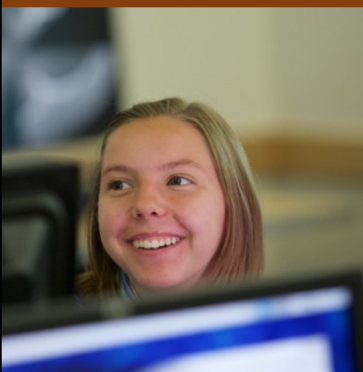
Sessions: 9AM-3PM
